Next, CG Flooring assessed the results of the survey and carried out corrective grinding on the three floors to comply with the AutoStore flooring specification



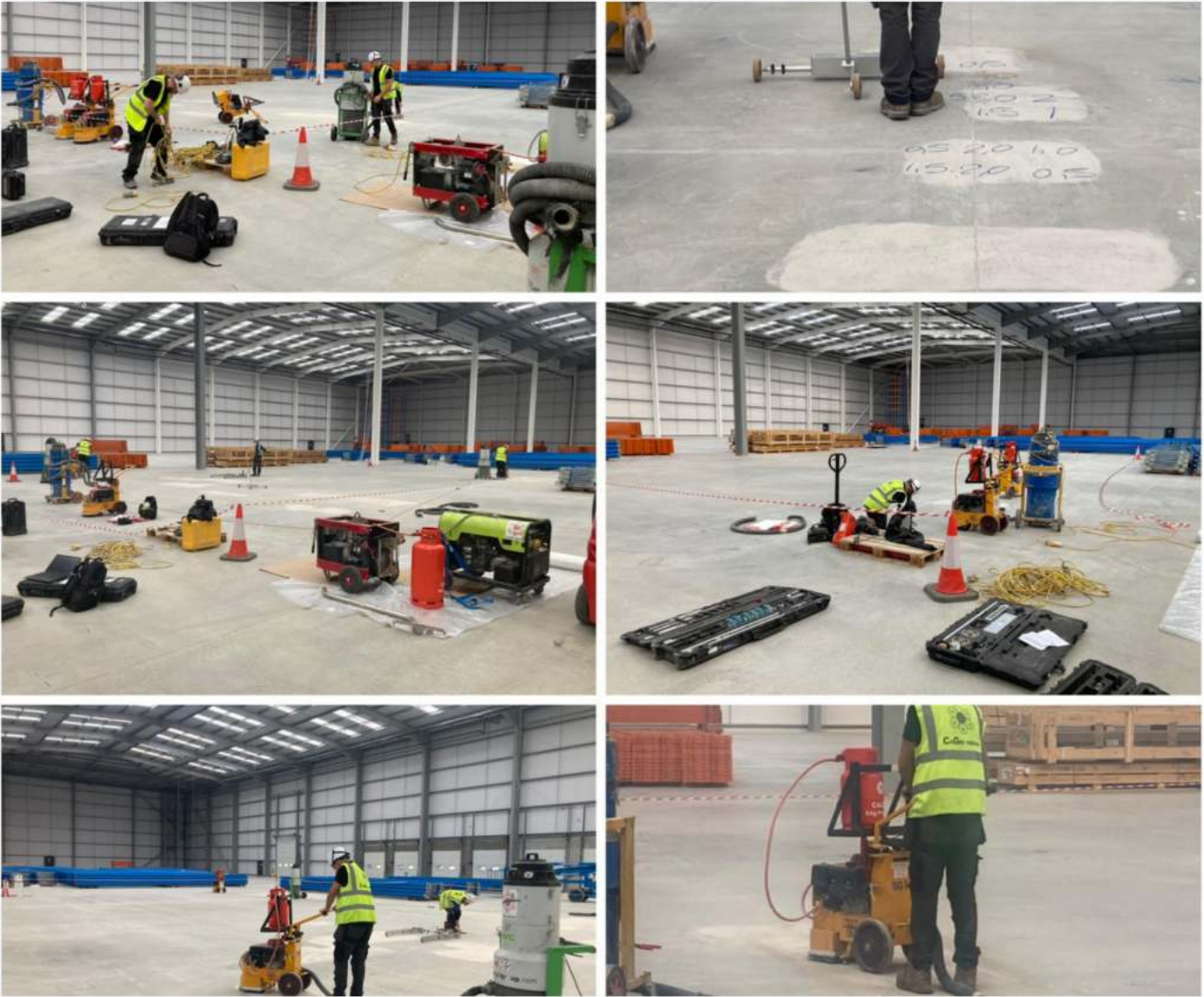
